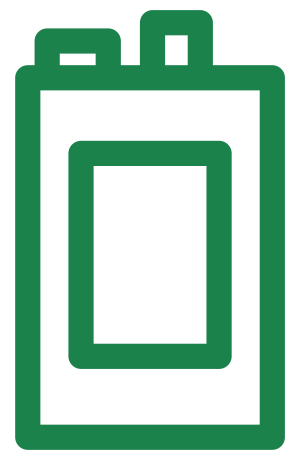


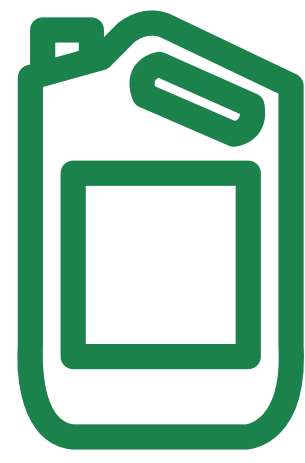
Drains Are Not Dumps

Hazardous substances are found in many common products. Dense non-aqueous phase liquids, or DNAPLs, are especially toxic substances that are sometimes found in the products below. Toxic even in small amounts, they are almost impossible to remove once they contaminate a water supply. PREVENTION is the key to dealing with DNAPLs.

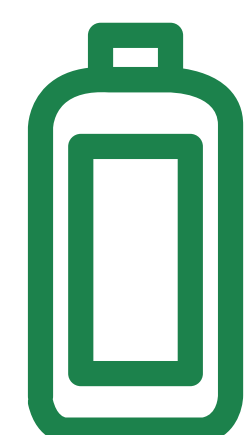
