Consultation on Proposed Amendments to Trent Assessment Report
and Trent Source Protection Plan

Pursuant to the *Clean Water Act, 2006* Section 34(3)
and Ontario Regulation 287/07, Section 50(1) and (4)

The public is invited to comment on proposed amendments to the Trent Assessment Report and Trent Source Protection Plan.

The Trent Assessment Report identifies threats to the quality and quantity of municipal drinking water sources. The Trent Source Protection Plan contains policies to address drinking water threats.

Recent upgrades to the **Norwood Municipal Well System** have changed the area where specific activities can be a drinking water threat. Amendments to the Trent Assessment Report and the Trent Source Protection Plan have been proposed to reflect these changes.

An **Open House** will be hosted by the Township of Asphodel-Norwood on Wednesday, April 3, 2019 from 4:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Office (2357 County Road 45, Norwood).
