The unique geological history of the Warsaw Caves area has resulted in some cool rock features and formations.

As you walk the trails the structure of the bedrock and its characteristic fracturing pattern is clearly visible.



You'll also see a number of small rockmills and larger kettles which were formed when granite stones trapped in the river current were spun around in place, grinding their way into the underlying limestone.
