SPACE INVADERS

Invasive species are plants or animals that have been introduced to a new habitat intentionally or accidentally. Trails and Conservation Areas are susceptible to invasive species because of the large volume of visitor traffic they see year-round.

Invasive species grow and spread rapidly, outcompeting the native flora and fauna and negatively impacting the ecosystem
